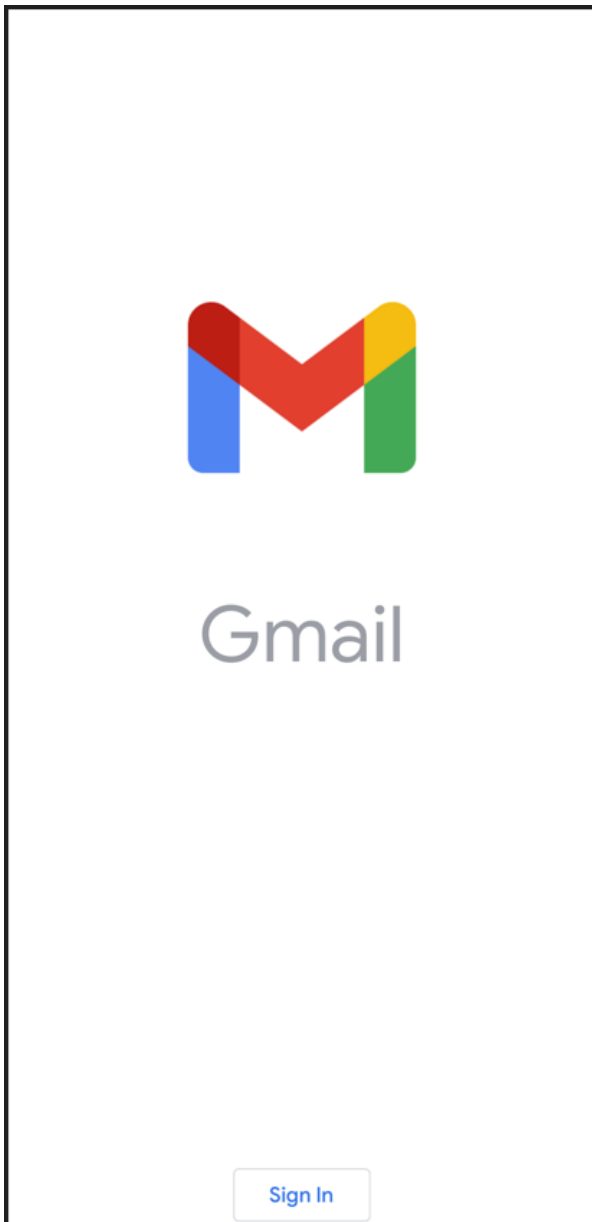


Setting up the Gmail app on a phone.

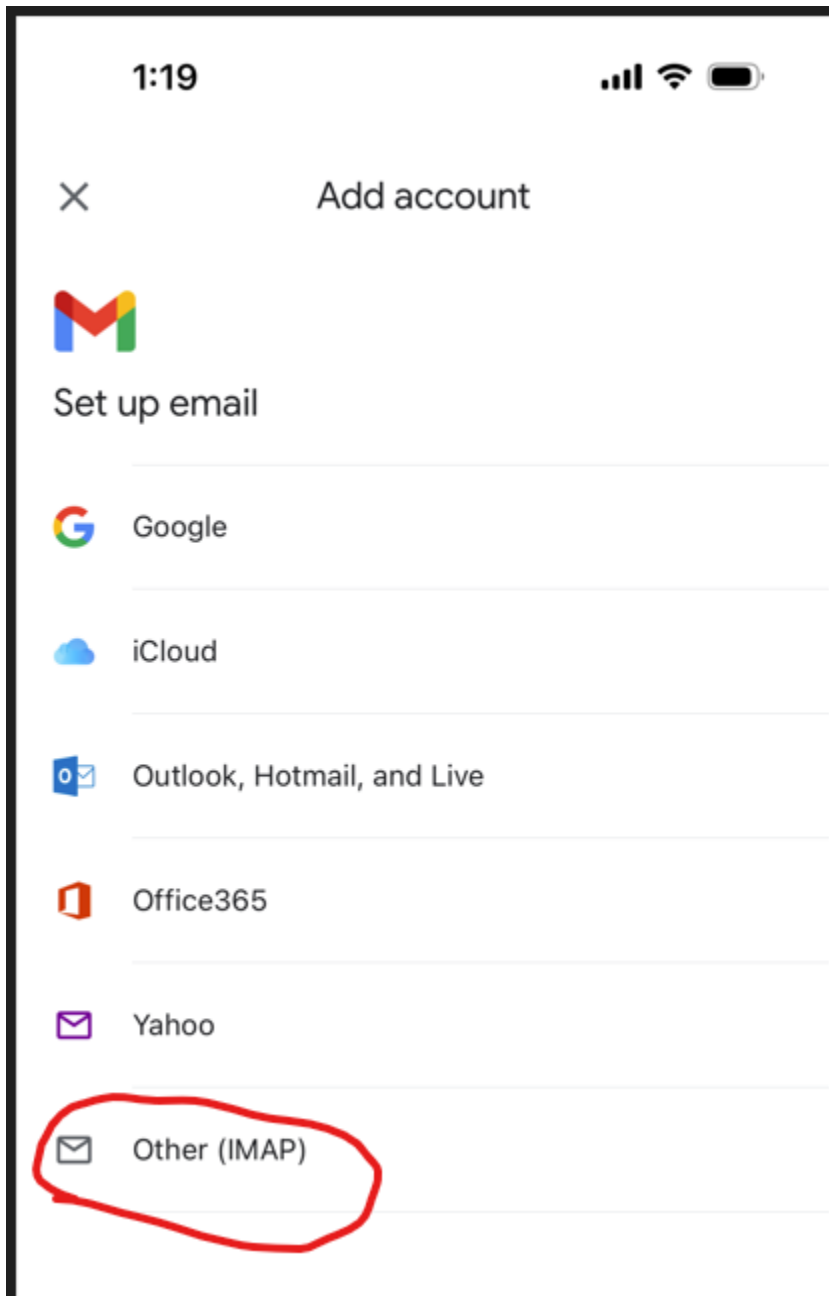
It turns out that you can use the Gmail app on phones to work with other email like POP and IMAP accounts. Here is how you would set that up.

When you open the gmail app, and you haven't set up any accounts, then it will display the next screen.

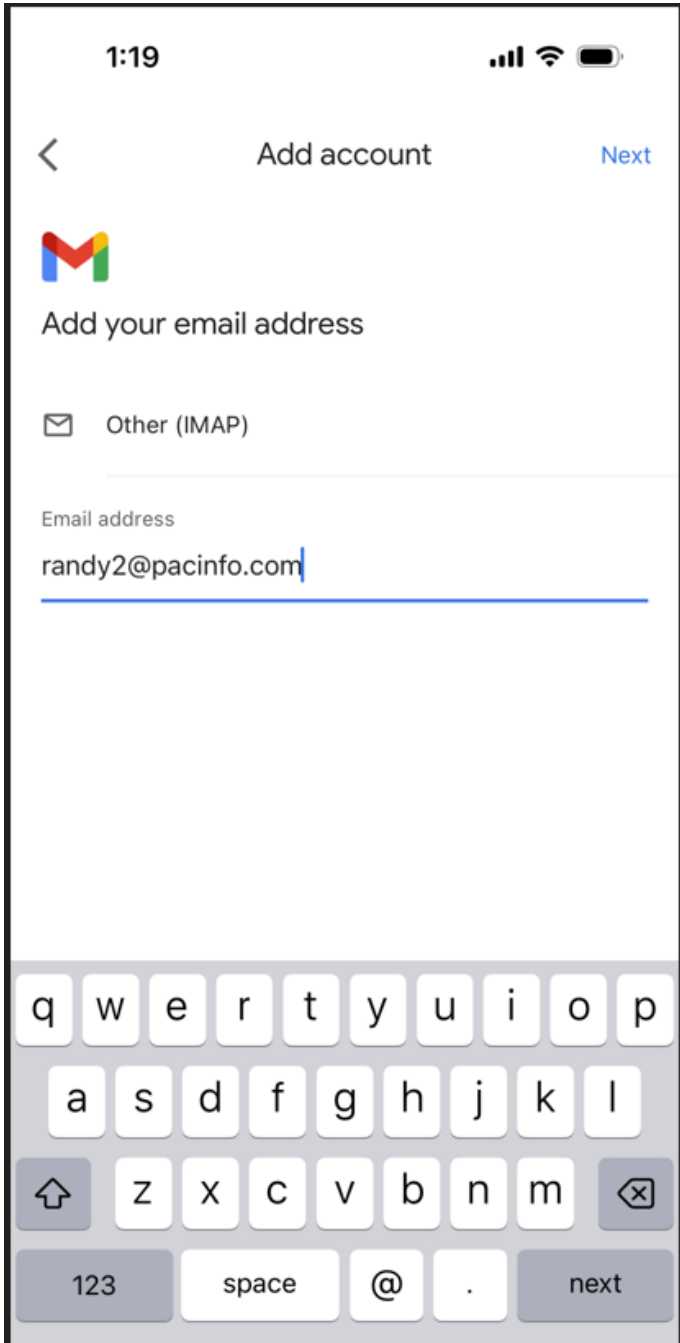
Just click on the sign in button and it will start the process to add an account.



The next screen asks what kind of account you want to work with. You want to select “other IMAP” for emails on the PacInfo server.



Enter your email address and click Next in the upper right and it will go to the next screen.



For the incoming server settings, enter your email address, password.


IMAP server is mail.pacinfo.com

Port is 993 and security is SSL/TLS

Click Next in the upper right and it will verify the settings and go to the next screen for the outgoing server setup.


Enter the information to match the image below.
