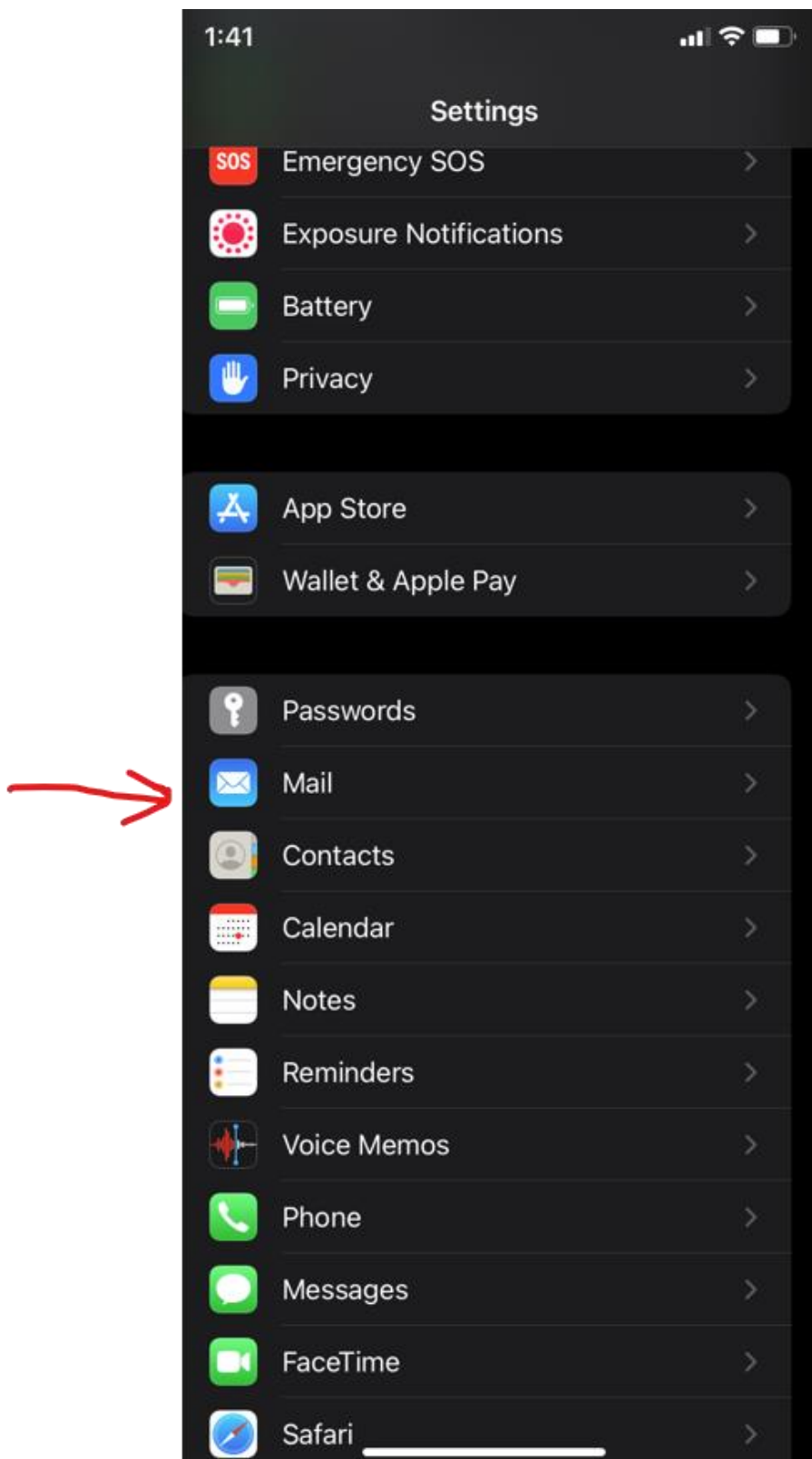


Setting up email on iphone.

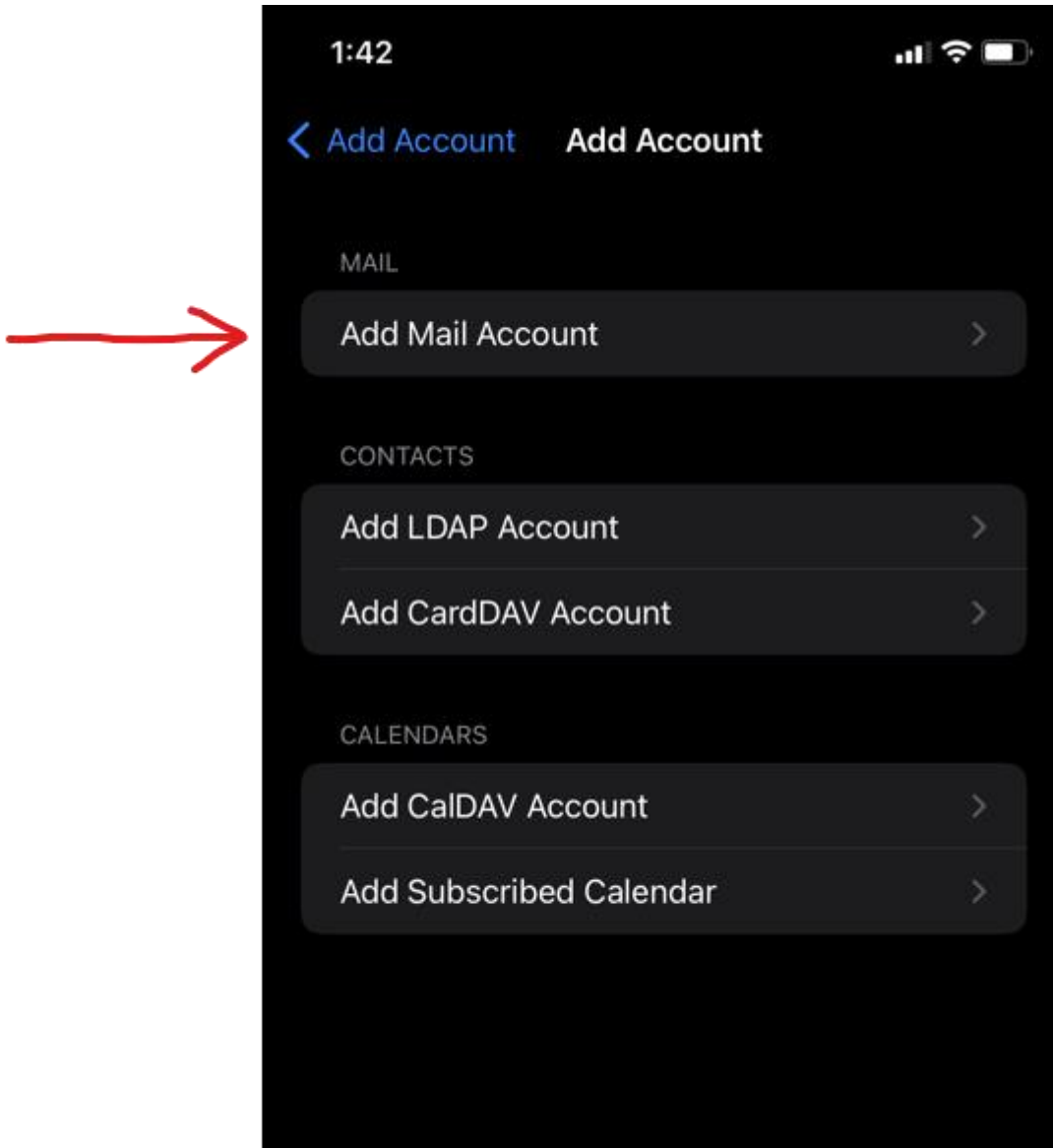

Most Apple mail programs, say the username and password are optional for the outgoing mail server. They are NOT OPTIONAL. If you don't enter them, you won't be able to send email. In case you make this mistake, you can just get back into the account settings, for the outgoing server and enter the information after the fact and it will then work fine.
